A.

The design proposed has limitations. -

1. impractical to use in southerly blow.
2. limited to only one boat at the time.
3. Dangerous to use in a southerly blow

B.

A pontoon deck constructed in a West-south alignment would have more advantages.

1. it would be easier to ~~use~~ berth in a northerly -
NOR-west & a southerly blow.

2. (with the future in mind) it could berth two boats at the time

- Conclusion -

A. For the extra money you would have a SAFER - more practicable - and versatile berthing, which would serve akaroa much longer than the existing plans - this is a good time to get it right.

B. it would have to be built in such a way as NOT TO bump ^{the} wharf in a southerly blow as boats on this side pound the wharf & buildings

C. would not impact on existing users as because of the limitations of the East west alignment it is not always used & with the increased activity the extra berth is well needed!!!

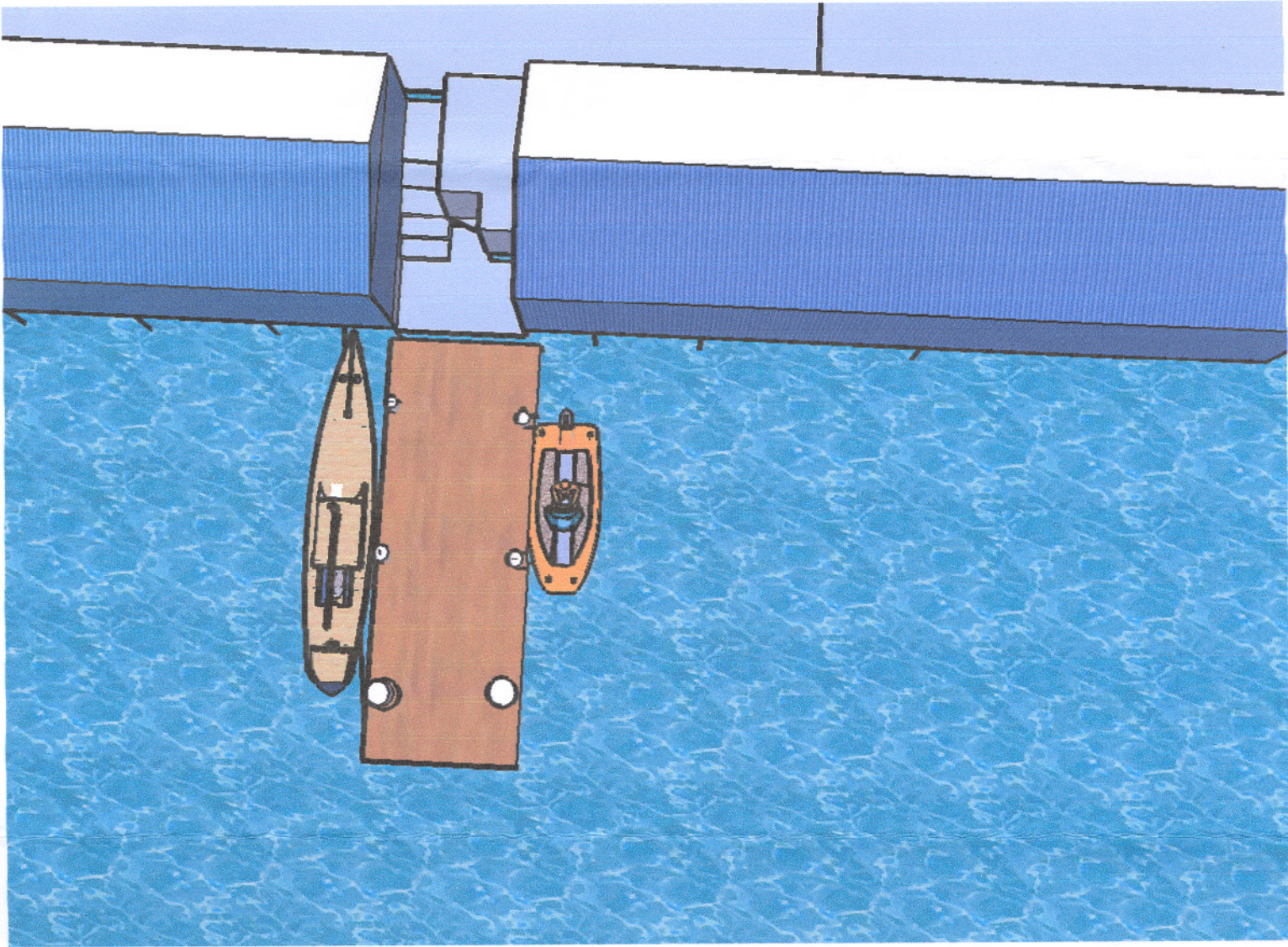
