### SUBMISSION FOR CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL

ANNUAL DRAFT PLAN 2007/2008 (9th May 2007)

Dear Sir/ Madam

I am writing to you to submit the following:

That the riverbanks of the city of Christchurch remain with the English trees, especially the weeping willow trees only on the river banks and continue to allow those rate payers and citizens who are not influenced by Maori, to have our city river banks back. Over the last twenty or so years, these spectacular and tranquil willow trees that have had such an influence in our daily lives, have slowly been replaced with other trees, toi toi and flax.

One can see around them and that no one is hiding or lurking, waiting to attack. This is very comforting for those people who like to walk the dog, take an evening stroll or have picnic lunch on the riverbanks.




- 3) Social problems. The city is not without it's social problems and the present councils plan to replace willow trees with native trees and fauna such as flax and toi toi. This can only encourage those teens who run away from home to sleep in amongst this new haven for lost souls, just as the charity clothing bins dotted around the city have done so for several decades now.
- 4) Rats. Flax and toi toi, as well as giving a scruffy appearance to the river banks, encourage rats.
- 5) White willow is an ancient healing aid from my generation and I gain comfort from seeing the Willows; shows me that my culture is not completely subjugated in this city. Please don't take away every bit of our culture and replace it with the way things were along the river banks, before the forefather's of the city did their plan. If we are ever to move forward as a people and as a country, we need to respect each other. This is an equally a spiritual experience for me as being in the serene and peaceful native forests of this country.
