## Railway Station and Public Transport

① I would like the council to consider moving the Christchurch Railway Station back to the old railway station in Moorhouse Avenue.

The station at Tower Junction is not suitable where it is because:

- (a) It is not easy to get to on public transport
- (b) is not in the central city and not suitable if it is to be used for public transport in the Christchurch area.
- (c) It is not visible from the main road

- (d) It is not in a good place to promote Christchurch and New Zealand

If the railway station is moved back to Moorhouse Avenue it will promote the above and our Transalpine and Transcoastal rail journey's.

② I would like the council to consider using trains on the existing railway tracks for public transport in the Christchurch area.

This could be used for the area's (a) Central - Belfast - Kaiapoi - Pungiaora (b) Central - Riccarton - Hornby (c) Central - Lyttelton

This would ease the traffic congestion in Christchurch and lower air pollution

The price of petrol is high at the moment and will most probably go higher in the future

I also love trains and it would be great to see more trains in Christchurch.

It would not cost much to implement this
