The purpose of this report is to seek the approval of the Board to install four bus stops in Foremans Road

Earlier this year this year the Community Board and Council resolved to prohibit vehicles greater than nine metres in length from traversing the rail crossing on Halswell Junction Road at Waterloo Road in a north bound direction. This action was taken to prevent long vehicles overhanging the rail crossing when queued at the intersection thus reducing the potential for a collision with a train.

As a consequence of this restriction it is necessary to alter the number 25 Templeton bus route. In consultation with the Canterbury Regional Council it has been decided that the buses will now travel down Foremans Road instead of Waterloo Road. The route will join the existing via Parker Street. A plan is attached.

Four new bus stops are necessary along Foremans Road (two on either side). The desirable locations are at either end. A number of property owners were interviewed before consent to locate a stop was forthcoming. The owners of the properties appearing in the recommendation have no objection to a bus stop.

A plan is attached.
