

4. WATERLOO ROAD – PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek the approval of Council to install a parking restriction on Waterloo Road (collector road).

A request for a parking restriction has been received from the shopkeepers in the small block of shops on Waterloo Road, Islington.

With the exception of the hairdressers (at the end of the block), the shops rely on regular turnover of the available kerbside parking spaces. This is often compromised by clients of the hairdresser who can occupy the carparks for extended periods. Apparently the hairdresser has spoken to the clients but the problem has persisted.

The concerns of the shopkeepers can be addressed by installing a ten minute parking restriction along the frontage of the dairy and fish and chip shop, leaving the area outside the hairdresser unrestricted. The hairdresser has agreed to this.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be limited to a maximum of ten minutes at any time on the north side of Waterloo Road commencing at a point 95 metres west of the Gilbertthorpes Road intersection and extending 21 metres in a westerly direction.
