**15. MAIDSTONE ROAD/WAIMAIRI ROAD

Corporate Plan Output: Maidstone Road/Waimairi Road Intersection Improvements	

The purpose of this report is to convey to the Committee recommendations of the Fendalton/Waimairi and the Riccarton/Wigram Community Boards from their meetings last week.

1. Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board

The Board resolved:

- (a) That the proposal to install the Option 2 traffic signals at the Maidstone/Waimairi intersection proceed without the loss of car parks in front of the shops.
- (b) That planning and consultation for the restriction of the traffic volume on Wadeley Road in conjunction with associated capacity improvements at the Maidstone/Waimairi Intersection continue.
- (c) That the additional \$62,000 required for the Option 2 proposal be funded from within the City Streets Unit's capital works programme.
- (d) That Option 2 for improvement of the intersection be endorsed as a basis for public consultation.
- (e) That the Board be informed of the outcomes from the consultation process.
- (f) That the Council provide for the appropriate planning to progress Option 4 for implementation in as short a time frame as possible.

2. Riccarton/Wigram Community Board

The Board resolved:

- (a) That the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board support Option 2 for the installation of traffic signals at the Maidstone/Waimairi intersection without the loss of car parks in front of the shops.

- (b) That the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board facilitate a meeting of Wadeley Road, Ashford Place and Ilkley place residents to discuss the following traffic management options for Wadeley Road:
 - (i) Do nothing.
 - (ii) Place three or four speed humps on Wadeley Road.
 - (iii) Construct a series of chicaines on Wadeley Road.
 - (iv) Construct a combination of speed humps and chicaines on Wadeley Road.
