The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to approve the relocation of the mobile library stop in Keighleys Road.

In response to concerns about traffic safety on Keighleys Road at Bromley School a pedestrian crossing point with new kerb build outs is to be constructed. The present mobile library stop is in the position of the new kerb build out.

There is a bus stop to the west of the school. After discussions with adjoining property owners it was felt that the most appropriate place for the library mobile stop is to the west of the kerb build out before the bus stop.

To eliminate any problems for the mobile library it is recommended that the mobile library stop be relocated.

Recommendation:

- 1. That the mobile library stop that operates on Friday from 9.30 am to 9.45 am, on the north side of Keighleys Road commencing at a point 134.5 metres from its intersection with Korora Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres be revoked.
- 2. That a mobile library stop to operate on Fridays from 9.30am to 9.45am, be installed on the north side of Keighleys Road commencing at a point 102.5 metres from its intersection with Korora Street and extending in an easterly direction for 12 metres.
