

## 6. MAJOR HORN BROOK ROAD – PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that a 5 minute parking restriction be installed outside Mt Pleasant School.

Mt Pleasant School has a congestion problem on Major Hornbrook Road at the beginning and end of the school day. The school asked for this problem to be investigated and after a site meeting with the School Board of Trustees it has been suggested that a school drop off zone be created.

A 5 minute parking restriction between 8.30 and 9.30 am and 2.30 and 3.30 pm will give parents who are stopping for a short period to pick up and deliver children, a place to park. This will reduce congestion at the school gate and the number of vehicles parking on the broken yellow no parking lines to the south of the school.

**Recommendation:** That the Board recommend to Council that a “P5 8.30 –9.30 am and 2.30 – 3.30 pm” be installed on the east side of Major Hornbrook Road commencing at a point 31 metres from its intersection with Billys Track and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
