The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that a 5 minute parking restriction be installed outside Mt Pleasant School.

Mt Pleasant School has a congestion problem on Major Hornbrook Road at the beginning and end of the school day. The school asked for this problem to be investigated and after a site meeting with the School Board of Trustees it has been suggested that a school drop off zone be created.

A 5 minute parking restriction between 8.30 and 9.30 am and 2.30 and 3.30 pm will give parents who are stopping for a short period to pick up and deliver children, a place to park. This will reduce congestion at the school gate and the number of vehicles parking on the broken yellow no parking lines to the south of the school.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to Council that a "P5 8.30-9.30 am and $2.30-3.30 \mathrm{pm}$ " be installed on the east side of Major Hornbrook Road commencing at a point 31 metres from its intersection with Billys Track and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
