The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of a request by the shop owners and business operators from the shopping centre in Hampshire Street (number 35 to 67) for a P30 parking restriction in front of the shops.

The Hampshire Street shopping centre mainly caters for short-term retailing, but also has a Tavern, offices of the Department of Corrections, Mature Employment Service and Supergrans. All day parking is available on the street opposite the shops and in adjacent streets. Service access to these shops is available from the rear of each building.

The Parking Operations Manager is agreeable to the introduction of a P30 Parking restriction in this area.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of

30 minutes on the north western side of Hampshire Street commencing at a point 15 metres from its intersection with Portsmouth Street and extending in a south westerly direction for a

distance of 95 metres.
