The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of a reply to the concerns raised by Mr Phillip Haythornthwaite in his deputation to the Board at its November 1998 meeting.

Mr Haythornthwaite raised the following concerns:

1. For the design of the North Parade cycleway especially around the Banks Avenue/North Parade intersection.
 - Mr Haythornthwaite's concerns are noted and will be duly considered in the final stages of the Shirley Cycleway project currently being prepared by Cycle Planning Officer, Alix Newman. The project report will be presented to the Cycleway Working Party, of which Mr Haythornthwaite is a member.
2. The timing and position of the bus shelter to be installed outside the school and for an appropriate disabled access to be provided.
 - The proposed bus shelter is to be installed outside the school, early in 1999. Appropriate disabled access will be provided. A bus shelter on the east side of North Parade, opposite the school will be considered as part of the kerb and channel renewal work, which is programmed for 1999/00.
3. The timing for the upgrading of lighting in North Parade as per the annual plan.
 - The lighting upgrade contract has been let and work is expected to be completed by the middle of February 1999.

Recommendation: That the information be received, and Mr Haythornthwaite be informed of the action to be taken.
