The purpose of this report is to inform Councillors of progress with the Trade Wastes Bylaw review.

The Council authorised a process of review in August 1997 and appointed Councillors Evans and Howell as a Sub-Committee to liaise with staff and industry representatives to produce a new Bylaw.

Good agreement has been reached between these parties and the Bylaw is now being checked by solicitors as to the best way of wording the agreed conditions and ensuring it conforms with the Local Government Act. It is intended to report more fully to the Council in March or April and set in motion the formal procedures required by the Act as shown on the barchart attached. A new sub-committee now needs to be appointed to hear submissions and the like.

At this stage it is not expected the new Bylaw will have large implications for Council revenue.
