

7. KEDLESTONE DRIVE-PROPOSED BUS STOP

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to consider the installation of a new bus stop outside 73 Kedleston Drive on the No 24 (Hyde Park) bus route as shown on the **appended** plan.

BACKGROUND

A request has been received that a new inbound bus stop be installed thirty metres from the existing outbound stop at 78 Kedleston Drive. The residents at 73 Kedleston Drive are in agreement with the proposed bus stop being outside their property. There is a distance of 165 metres and 150 metres to the nearest inbound bus stops (in each direction), neither of which are visible from the proposed stop. The Canterbury Regional Council's David Berry has been consulted and is in agreement with the proposal.

PROPOSAL

Considering the above information it is appropriate for a new inbound bus stop to be installed at 73 Kedleston Drive.

Recommendation: That a Bus Stop be installed outside the property of 73 Kedleston Drive on the No. 24 Bus Route.
