The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council the extension of the broken yellow lines in Ferry Road in the vicinity of Nursery Road.

The Council has a long-standing intention to complete the cycle route from Hagley Park to Sumner. The majority of the City to Sumner cycle route is in place and the overall route primarily consists of cycle lanes.

At present vehicles travelling east drive in the cycle lane as they approach the Ferry Road/Nursery Road intersection. To eliminate this problem and smooth the transition for cyclists at the intersection it is necessary to extend the broken yellow no parking lines. This will remove ten metres of parking space and allow more road space for the vehicle and cycle lanes.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to Council the following resolutions:

- 1. That the stopping of vehicles at any time on the north side of Ferry Road commencing at the intersection of Nursery Road and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 19 metres be revoked.
- 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the north side of Ferry Road commencing at the intersection of Nursery Road and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 29 metres.
