Corporate Plan Output: Traffic Signs and Markings	

The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of a “Give Way” control against Ti Rakau Drive at its intersection with Dyers Road.

Traffic travelling on Ti Rakau Drive is experiencing difficulty with vehicles turning right from Dyers Road not giving way to right turning traffic. The intersection has a large planted splitter island, as it is the entrance to the Brookhaven subdivision. This island adds to the confusion that is occurring.

Dyers Road carries a large volume of heavy traffic and the speed limit on this stretch of road is 70km/hr. It is part of the ring road route and is the designated route from the north to the port.

A “Give Way” control against Ti Rakau Drive would improve safety at the intersection and remove any confusion for right turning traffic from either road.

Recommendation: That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Ti Rakau Drive at its intersection with Dyers Road.

Chairman’s Recommendation: That the Board adopt the above recommendations.
