Agreed that the issues/areas of responsibility for this Committee are:

- Natural Resources

2. **CURRENT ISSUES – FAMILIARISATION INSPECTION**

In discussing previous and current issues members **agreed** that a two-ward familiarisation inspection would be most beneficial.

The Riccarton inspection is scheduled (as part of the next Committee meeting) for Tuesday 16 February at 4.00pm.

Amongst the current issues identified for viewing are:

- *Streetscape Enhancement* (placing of trees etc)
Resident groups will be asked to identify possible streets.
- “*Street Pride*” *Scheme* (information tabled)
- *Waterways*
Through residential and commercial areas
Maintenance and enhancement
- *Open Green Space*
Looking at current and future park development sites
- *Cycling Networks*
- *Air Quality (ie Riccarton Road)*

Other current issues which could be more relevant to a Wigram inspection include:

- *Stock Truck Effluent*
(will be discussed at 16 February meeting)
- *Welcome Signs*
Identifying suitable sites, appropriate signage standards, landscaping.
- *Rural Waterways, Pits etc*
Enhancement
