

**8. CONTRACT NO 98/99-243
DISRAELI STREET ROAD RECONSTRUCTION FROM SELWYN STREET
TO ANTIGUA STREET**

The purpose of this report is to obtain Board approval for acceptance of a tender which is above the \$300,000 authority delegated to Council Officers.

The contract is for the construction of kerbs and flat channels, mountable median kerbs, traffic islands, asphaltic concrete paths, landscape planting, grassed berms, minor drainage works, full carriageway reconstruction etc.

This contract is to follow major sewer and stormwater pipeline construction.

Tender prices have been received as follows:

(Note that two companies have priced an alternative to be appointed contractor for both the major sewer and stormwater piping work and the roading work.)

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$36,000 and the work is for a thirteen week period.

The estimate for the work was \$383,000. The lower prices received are indicative of the competitive roading contract market at present.

This roading work is being preceded by a contract for new stormwater piping and the replacement of the sewer main. Works Operations are the contractor for this work.

The City Streets Unit is financing the stormwater and piping work this financial year and the Water Services Unit have given a commitment to make a similar contribution to the City Streets Unit to fund this roading contract.

The standard roadworks information leaflet has been circulated inviting comments relating to the project and all inquiries and comments from residents

and others have been satisfactorily resolved (refer attached). Changes have had to be made to the design shown on the publicity leaflet.

Mr Colin Sloss of Local Construction Limited has given an assurance that the work can be completed within the specified time.

Recommendation: That the lowest price conforming tender of Local Construction Limited for the sum of \$328,054.55 be accepted.
