

4. AVONHEAD ROAD – KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of the proposal to provide the south side of Avonhead Road with a concrete kerb and channel from Hawthornden Road to No.513 as shown on the **following** publicity plan. As Avonhead Road is a collector road any substantive issues raised by the Community Board will be reported to the City Services Committee.

BACKGROUND

This urban section of Avonhead Road has had a rural stormwater disposal system up to the present time. To improve the situation, the Five Year Capital Works Programme has allowed for the construction in the 1999/2000 financial year. The concrete kerb and stormwater channel will be constructed along the edge of the existing chip seal road surface to improve drainage off the road reserve and formalise the boundary between the grass berms and the edge of the seal. With the Board's approval, it is proposed to distribute the publicity plan to those residents that are affected by the proposed work.

Recommendation: That the information be received and the Board endorse the plan for circulation for public comment.
