The purpose of this report is to bring members of the Projects and Property Committee up to date with progress on the Pioneer Sports Stadium Project.

#### **REPORT PERIOD ENDING 31 MAY 1999**

#### PROJECT PHASE: CONSTRUCTION

#### GENERAL (Progress)/PROGRAMME

The building was officially handed over by the contractor as programmed on Monday 31 May 1999. The signage tower to Lyttelton Street should be installed before the opening date.

All mechanical plant damaged by the pipe burst on 3/4 May has been repaired or replaced. Some minor paint repairs are still to be completed. All repair/replacement costs will be covered by insurance.

The mains water pressure in the PVC pipe which burst was within the design and pipework parameters and the cause of the pipe burst has yet to be determined.

As a precautionary risk management measure the PVC pipework has been replaced with galvanised steel pipework at a cost of approximately \$11,000.

The preview for Council staff and the public will take place on Sunday 6 June and the official opening will take place on 8 June. The pools will open to the public on 9 June.
