

## 23. FUNDING APPLICATIONS FROM SCHOOLS

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Corporate Plan Output: Discretionary Fund 3.1.15	

The purpose of this report is to consider applications for funding referred from the Community Funding Committee.

At its meeting on 10 May the Community Funding Committee referred the following applications to the Community Board for funding consideration:

<i>Mairehau Primary School</i>	Build a playground facility for 9 year olds.	3,000
<i>Ouruhia School</i>	Building a new netball, basketball, tennis court area.	2,000
<i>Papanui High School First XI Hockey</i>	Purchase of hockey equipment and uniforms.	3,000
<i>Papanui Primary Senior Syndicate Swimmers</i>	Coaching for school pupils in aquatic skills.	1,070
<i>Papanui School Childrens Winter Sports Club</i>	Coaches for School Winter Sports Club.	1,400

In addition to the above, an application was also received from the Redwood School for a grant of \$5,000 towards the school's planned upgrade of junior and senior playground equipment project. The school is planning to replace the current equipment that no longer complies with Occupational Safety and Health Standards, with two new adventure playgrounds. The total cost of the equipment is \$37,372.

The school welcomes community use of its facilities.

At a meeting on 26 May the Board considered a policy to establish guidelines to apply to applications from schools for funding (refer clause 22).
