

**11. PROPOSED NEW RIGHT OF WAY NAME 86 CONWAY STREET RR 10024**

The purpose of this report is to request the approval of the Board of one new right-of-way name.

**SPR/98/429                                  86 Conway Street**  
**Riccarton Developments Limited        Spreydon Ward**

This subdivision creates six new allotments served by a right-of-way, running south east off Conway Street

The applicant has submitted names for approval before, but as they have all been names already in use in Christchurch, they have not been placed before the Board for approval.

There are no ideas for names from the Certificate of Title, so the applicant has chosen a list of names in order of preference from a list of names prepared by the subdivision office for use. Of the five names supplied, only one Phoebe (the name of a small boat that plied the Heathcote River) has an historical connection with Christchurch. The right-of-way though is not very long, so perhaps Nina Lane may be more suitable. (Nina is taken from the name of one of the sailing ships in Christopher Columbus's voyage to America.)

**Recommendation:** That either Nina Lane or Phoebe Lane be approved for the above right of way.
