Corporate Plan Output: Waste Collection	

The purpose of this report is to seek approval from the Burwood/Pegasus Community Board to allow refuse collection in a private lane. A formal application has been received from the manager of the Kate Sheppard Life Care Centre to have refuse bins and recycling crates collected from each unit. At the present time all bags and crates have to be taken by residents to a collection point at the entrance to the complex on New Brighton Road. This is not practicable for the residents many of whom are unwell with restricted mobility. The staff at the complex have been responsible for collection and stockpiling the bags and crates until this time.

There are 64 units in the complex with a high rate of changes of ownership. For this reason, rather than individual acceptance from each unit owner, Waste Management has allowed the manager, Donna O'Reilly, to sign an acceptance of conditions and service on behalf of all residents. All other criteria including a test run with a truck from Onyx have been met and therefore Board approval is now sought.

Recommendation: That the Board approve collection of refuse from the Kate Sheppard Life Care Centre.
