The purpose of this report is to bring the Board up to date as to the road stopping at Hulverstone Drive. The road stopping is to enable the bridge over the Avon River to be constructed as part of the 'Ring Road'.

One objection was received when the Council called for objections in January 1995. As the objector would not withdraw his objection after a Council Hearing the matter was sent to the Environment Court for a determination. The Court has now released its decision and they have confirmed the Council's decision to stop the two portions of Hulverstone Drive as shown on the attached plan and described in the schedule hereto.
