The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of a request from the South Brighton School Board of Trustees and to recommend to Council the installation of parking restrictions outside the School on Estuary Road (see attached).

The concern is for the dropping off and picking up of students outside the school on Estuary Road at school times. Estuary Road has a collector road status in the City Plan and carries a daily average of 3,400 vehicles. To overcome this concern a short-term parking restriction is proposed. A P5 restriction is proposed to apply during the hours of 8.00 to 9.00 am and 2.30 to 3.30 pm on Monday to Friday outside the school.

The Acting Principal of the School Miss Barbara Martin and Julie Burgess Supervising Parking Officer of the City Council Parking Operations Unit support this parking restriction proposal.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend the following parking change to Council:

That parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 5 minutes between the hours of 8.00 to 9.00am, 2.30 to 3.30pm, Monday to Friday on the western side (generally) of Estuary Road, commencing at a point 124 metres from its intersection with Cradock Street and extending in a southern direction (generally) for a distance of 44 metres.

Chairperson's Recommendations:

- 2. That the Board request rigorous initial education and enforcement of the area by the Parking Operations Unit
