The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to formalise the "Give Way" sign and road markings in Wetlands Grove at its intersection with Bexley Road.

The proposal to construct a traffic island on Wetlands Grove and install a right turn bay from Bexley Road into Wetlands Grove, was in response to traffic safety concerns at the intersection by the Bexley Residents Association (*see attached plan, page 21*). A pamphlet explaining the proposed work was distributed to residents in October 1998, and it was generally accepted. This work is expected to be completed by the end of March 1999.

It is now appropriate to formalise the installation of the "Give Way" sign and road markings.

Recommendations:

- 1. That the Board approve the installation of a "Give Way" sign in Wetlands Grove at its intersection with Bexley Road.
- 2. That the Board recommend to Council, that the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the west side of Bexley Road commencing at a point 20 metres north of its intersection with Wetlands Grove and extending to a point 50 metres south from the intersection.
