

### 13. STREET LIGHTING OUTSIDE AVONSIDE GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL

Corporate Plan Output:	

Board members will recall that at the meeting held to prioritise capital works for the Annual Plan, Board members considered concerns raised by the Avonside Girls' High School at the level of lighting outside the school.

This matter was raised with the Asset Management Engineer: Street Lighting, Geoff English, who reports as follows:

*“On inspection of the lights outside Avonside Girls' High School I noticed the light fittings were very dirty and the lamps very old and dim. The fittings have been cleaned and the lamps replaced which has dramatically increased the output of these lights. The lighting is to a good local road standard.*

*The lighting in Chester Street East outside Crichton Cobbers Youth Club has recently been upgraded in conjunction with the underground conversion of services in this road. The lighting is to a high local road standard.*

*The sharp bend in Hurley Street is actually an entrance to a housing complex off the end of the street. I have arranged for a light to be installed on the existing power pole at the end of the street, as this will also provide light to the adjacent reserve.”*
