The purpose of this report is to advise the Board of the details of this Contract and obtain approval to have tenders reported direct to the Board after tenders close.

The tenders will exceed the \$300,000 authority delegated to Council Officers.

This new road has come from submissions regarding the relocation of the main entrance to the Ferrymead Historic Park from Bridle Path Road to Truscotts Road.

A Resource consent based on providing access to Ferrymead from both Truscotts Road and Bridle Path Road has been granted.

The Contract is for the construction of a new 10.5 m wide chipsealed access road to Ferrymead Historic Park between Truscotts Road and Bridle Path Road. Also included is the construction of swales, fencing, kerbs, channels, asphaltic concrete paths, grassed berms, landscaping, drainage works and road shoulder restoration.

Tenders were advertised on 13 March 1999 and closed on 24 March 1999.

A separate report on the results of the tenders will be produced prior to the Board meeting on 31 March 1999.
