The purpose of this report is to obtain Board approval for acceptance of a tender which is above the \$300,000 authority delegated to Council Officers.

The contract is for the construction of kerbs, channels, asphaltic concrete paths, grassed berms, tree planting, drainage work and full carriageway reconstruction for the whole length of Pannell Avenue from Kerrs Road to Wainoni Road. Also included are some kerb and channel replacement for Kerrs Road from Wainoni Road to Pannell Avenue (east side only).

Tender prices have been received as follows:

KB Quarries	\$320,459.80
Works Civil Construction	\$326,339.99
Waddell Holdings Limited	\$333,606.47
Local Construction Limited	\$335,879.00
BD Construction Limited	\$340,540.51
Works Operations Unit	\$371,296.27

All prices exclude GST.

These prices include a contingency sum of \$30,000 and the work is for a ten (10) week period.

The estimate for the work was \$339,300.

The standard roadworks information leaflet has been circulated inviting comments relating to the project and all enquiries and comments from residents and others have been satisfactorily resolved (*refer attached, page 57*). No changes have had to be made to the design shown on the publicity leaflet.

Mike Blair of KB Quarries has given an assurance that the work can be completed within the specified time.

Recommendation: That the lowest price conforming tender of KB Quarries for the sum of \$320,459.80 be accepted.
