Corporate Plan Output: Signals Signs and Shelters 9.5.94	

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to install “Give Way” signs in Sandra Street at the intersection with Pine Avenue.

Residents have expressed concern over traffic movements at the intersection of Sandra Street and Pine Avenue. Sandra Street provides an access between Marine Parade and Estuary Road, and at its mid point, intersects Pine Avenue in an off-set manner. Some drivers proceed straight through this off-set thinking that they have the right of way instead of treating the intersection as two separate ‘T’ intersections. There is also confusion in the right of way when a vehicle wishes to make a right turn into Sandra Street at the same time as a vehicle wishes to make a right turn out.

As part of the Southshore/South New Brighton LATMS it is proposed to consider the installation of a mild traffic restraint at this intersection which will rectify these problems when the budget is prioritised for this work.

In the meantime, the installation of “Give Way” signs will improve the safety at this intersection.

Recommendation: That “Give Way” signs be placed against Sandra Street at its intersection with Pine Avenue.
