The purpose of this report is to advise the Board on the funding proposal for the installation of a pedestrian refuge island in Golf Links Road.

The Board will recall the report to the 3 May 1999 meeting proposing a pedestrian refuge island in Golf Links Road, as a result of a request from Norma Hill of the Windsor Rest Home. The island will make it safer for the elderly residents of the Home to cross the road to The Palms shopping centre. The estimated cost for this work is \$15,000.

The Board resolved, "to fund \$4,000 from its 1998/1999 Discretionary Funds and \$3,500 from its 1999/2000 Discretionary Funds towards the pedestrian refuge island in Golf Links Road, and request the City Streets Unit to fund the additional \$7,500."

City Streets Unit will provide \$7,500 from its 1999/2000 Pedestrian Initiatives Budget for this work.
