The purpose of this report is to inform the Canterbury Waste Subcommittee about recent action taken by the Christchurch City Council in this regard.

BACKGROUND

Local Government New Zealand (LGNZ) has its annual conference on 14 July 1999. In order to advance a national approach on waste minimisation the Christchurch City Council on 22 April resolved to submit the remit to LGNZ for consideration at its July conference:

- 1. That Local Government New Zealand approaches central government proposing that LGNZ establishes a working party involving appropriate representatives from local government, central government, industry and commerce with a brief to investigate and advise government on what legislative and other national initiatives are needed to ensure that waste minimisation is achieved in New Zealand.
- 2. That the working party be requested to report back to the LGNZ year 2000 conference.

A copy of the relevant report is attached for information. A remit also requires support from five Territorial Local Authorities and such support has been obtained from members of the Canterbury Waste Subcommittee.
