The purpose of this report is to ask the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board to consider not proceeding with the proposed pedestrian refuge in Greers Road opposite Burnside High School.

BACKGROUND

Correspondence has been received from both Burnside High and Christ the King Schools requesting that the proposed pedestrian refuge in Greers Road opposite the two schools not proceed because they believe there is no need for it.

The previous Community Board allocated monies for the possible construction of a third pedestrian refuge in Greers Road (if required) after the flush or painted median and two pedestrian refuges were installed in 1998 between Memorial Avenue and Guildford Street.

PROPOSAL

In response to the school's requests, it is proposed that the monies be carried over into the new financial year and the money reallocated to an appropriate work.

- Recommendations:**
1. That the monies put aside for a proposed pedestrian refuge in Greers Road be carried over into the next financial year for reallocation by the Board.
 2. That staff be asked to find a suitable replacement project in the Board's area.
