

17. PLAQUES FOR HERITAGE BUILDINGS

Each year the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board approves the presentation of two plaques to commemorate the significance of two heritage buildings in the Hagley/Ferrymead area. Last year the former Sumner Borough Council building and the former Nurse Maude District Nursing Association building were selected to receive these heritage plaques.

The cost of preparing these plaques is approximately \$900. The Board should consider making available this sum from its Discretionary Fund to allow for the costs of making and attaching these building plaques. In the event that the cost of doing this exceeds \$800, the Environmental Policy and Planning Unit has offered to meet any additional costs incurred.

Recommendation: That the Board provide the sum of \$900 to meet the cost of two heritage building plaques from its 1999/2000 discretionary fund.
