### **PROJECT PHASE: DESIGN**

### **GENERAL** (**Progress**)

Contract documentation is progressing well with tender documents programmed to be available on 10 May. Tenders will close on 26 May and the tender evaluation/recommendation report will be presented to the June Projects and Property Committee meeting.

The Resource Consent planner is currently obtaining neighbours' consent for the project from affected neighbours and this should mean that the Consent can be handled on a non-notified basis.

### **REGISTRATIONS OF INTEREST**

Registrations of interest for the main contract closed on 21 April.

A weighted attribute system was used to evaluate the 11 firms who registered an interest.

Following discussions with the Chairman of the Projects and Property Committee, it has been decided to invite the following firms to tender for the project:
