The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of the impending development of a Local Area Traffic Management scheme for an area of St Albans not previously covered by a scheme. This is a continuation of the programme to provide local traffic management for all of the suitable areas within the city.

The area to be covered is between Madras Street and Hills Road, from Bealey Avenue to Warrington Street.

The development of the scheme will require a good level of community involvement. A public meeting will need to be convened to initially register the local traffic concerns of the residents. Residents groups and any schools near this area will be contacted and a letter box drop outlining information on the meeting will be made to all residents/property owners in this area.

The public meeting is envisaged to proceed through:

- Introduction
- LATMS presentation
- Public comment
- Summary and closing address

During the meeting Basil Pettigrew will take comprehensive notes which will be used to ensure that the relevant issues are addressed by the LATMS.

There is a large amount of kerb and channel reconstruction work programmed for this area over the next few years. It is appropriate that wherever possible elements of the LATMS projects be coordinated with this work.
