15.4 PEDESTRIAN STRATEGY

The Christchurch City Council is developing a Pedestrian Strategy , which seeks to address the needs of pedestrians and to encourage walking. The Pedestrian Strategy has been developed to address the needs of pedestrians around Christchurch City and to encourage walking as a way of getting around and for health and recreation. The Strategy seeks to coordinate the different activities that the Council undertakes relating to pedestrians and to work to create a more pedestrian friendly City. In conjunction with the Cycle Strategy, the Public Transport Strategy and the Road Safety Strategy, the Pedestrian Strategy will form a part of the wider transport strategy for the City.

A draft strategy document will be available for public comment from 1 November 1999 and copies will be circulated to Board members at the meeting.
