## 6. MARINE PARADE - NO STOPPING RESTRICTIONS

The purpose of this report is for the Board to consider recommending to the Council that no stopping restrictions be imposed on narrowed sections of Marine Parade where offstreet parking has been provided.

To be consistent with the City Plan change in designation of Marine Parade from a Minor Arterial to a Collector, and after community input into the North New Brighton Neighbourhood Improvement Plan, it is appropriate to develop Marine Parade to cater for local traffic with a kerb to kerb width of not more than 12 metres.

Coast Care have recently extended the formalised parking areas and protected pedestrian access routes to the beach. Where off street parking has been provided, Marine Parade has been narrowed further and "no stopping" restrictions need to be installed in these areas.

Two areas of Marine Parade are involved - between Flemington Street and Lever Terrace and between Tovey Street and Caspian Street.

Recommendation: That the Council prohibits the stopping of vehicles at any time in the following locations:

1. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern kerb line of Tovey Street and extending 8 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
2. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 314 and extending 14 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 1 metre.
3. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern kerb line of Jervois Street and extending 30 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.
4. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 332 and extending 21 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 3 metres.
5. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 335 and extending 3 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 23 metres.
6. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 340 and extending 5 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 19 metres.
7. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern kerb line of Bellamy Avenue and extending 21 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 36 metres.
8. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern kerb line of Drake Street and extending 34 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 21 metres.
9. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 368 and extending 25 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
10. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern kerb line of Halsey Street and extending 6 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
11. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 525 and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
12. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 529 and extending 2 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 23 metres.
13. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern boundary of number 535 and extending 18 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
14. On the eastern side of Marine Parade commencing at a point opposite the northern kerb line of Caspian Street and extending 20 metres in a northerly direction and in a southerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
15. On the east side of Marine Parade commencing at a point of 678 metres from its intersection with Beach Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
16. On the east side of Marine Parade commencing at a point of 722 metres from its intersection with Beach Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.
17. On the east side of Marine Parade commencing at a point of 768 metres from its intersection with Beach Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 70 metres.
