The purpose of this report is to advise the Board of the details of this project for which tenders closed on 17 November 1999.

The contract is for the renewal of the kerbs, channels, road shoulders, footpaths and grass berms in Tui Street from Fendalton Road to Kahu Road and Roa Road from Tui Street to Kotare Street. The work consists of the construction of kerbs, channels, asphaltic concrete paths, drainage works, road shoulder restoration, landscape planting and cobblestone paving.

The standard roadworks information leaflet has been circulated inviting comments relating to the project and all enquiries and comments from residents and others have been satisfactorily resolved with the exception of one householder's concerns regarding parking outside his property.

The estimate for the work is \$575,000 which is above the \$300,000 authority delegated to Council officers. A tender registration process has been done and five companies have been invited to submit proposals. With tenders closing on 17 November, they are to be evaluated and a recommendation in relation to an acceptance will be made to the Board meeting on 23 November 1999.

Recommendation: That the information be received and the Board consider the tabled tender details and accompanying recommendation for this contract.
