

## 6. CORRESPONDENCE

### a) Advertising Bus Shelter – Clifton Bay

Board members will recall that at its previous meeting the Board decided to withdraw its approval for an advertising bus shelter at Clifton Bay, as it understood that the Sumner Residents' Association did not support this shelter.

The following letter has now been received from Mrs Shirley Fairhall, Chairperson of the Sumner Residents' Association.

*“The Sumner Residents' Association wishes to advise the Board that we have no objection to the replacement of the bus shelter in Clifton Bay with one of the new 'advertising type' bus shelters.*

*We have discussed the matter with local residents and have found most to be in favour.*

*We regret any inconvenience this delay in communicating our decision may have caused the Board.”*

### b) Funding for Heritage Building

The attached letter from Mrs E M Westlake, Secretary/Treasurer of the Brockworth Homestead Project of Heritage Youth Inc, seeks a grant of \$3,000 from the Board's Discretionary Fund towards the cost of relocating the Brockworth Homestead from Riccarton to the environs of Ferrymead Historic Park, to serve as the headquarters building for the Heritage Youth project. Heritage Youth supporters would undertake the restoration and refurbishment of the building.

As yet, a site has not been established for this building.
