The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval of the Board of one new road name and three new rights of way names.

1/ FER/99/813 St Lukes Street This subdivision creates sixteen new allotments served by a mutual right of way. Several names have been submitted in keeping with the existing surrounding streets (St Johns Street, St Lukes Street, St Marks Street and St Thomas Place) The names submitted are ST JUDES, ST TRINITY, ST MARYS and ST DAVIDS. The latter three names are very similar to existing names. ST JUDES LANE is preferred.

2/FER/98/791 Glenstrae Road This subdivision creates eight allotments served by a right of way off Glenstrae Road. The previous stage created a similar right of way that was named Gazelle Lane after one of the boats that used to sail up the Heathcote River. The names proposed for this stage are also after Heathcote River boats. The names submitted in order of preference are RIFLEMAN LANE, COMET LANE and ANTELOPE LANE.

3/FER/98/119 Connall Street This subdivision creates a new cul de sac serving fifteen new warehouses. The is in close proximity to the site of Thacker's Slipway, and adjoins the Heathcote River. The names submitted in order of preference are:

THACKERS QUAY, STREAMLET WAY, COMET CLOSE and VISION CLOSE. The latter three names are from the Heathcote River boats. Note: if Comet is approved in 2/above, it will need to be declined for this application.

Recommendation: That St Judes Lane, Rifleman Lane and Thackers Quay be approved

for use.
