39. a) Sumner School

The Area Engineer has received a letter and petition from the Board of Trustees at Sumner School. The parents and community have expressed concern about safety issues for pedestrians at and around the school gate. The petition had 243 signatures. Fifty eight of those who signed were from outside the Sumner area and fifty three lived on surrounding hill properties.

The School Board has requested that an investigation and assessment of the traffic and safety issues be carried out by the Area Engineer.

The Area Engineer has agreed to carry out an investigation and this will be reported back to the School Board and the Community Board.
