The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the installation of a P30 time limit parking zone on the north side of Bealey Avenue to the east of Colombo Street.

The kerb and channel is currently being replaced in Colombo Street between Bealey Avenue and Purchas Street. Included with the work on the eastern side is a landscaped area of kerb build-out into Bealey Avenue directly adjacent to the corner and in front of the chemist shop. This development is primarily for traffic management purposes to provide a better siting for the traffic signals.

It is proposed that the existing area of time limit parking be moved along Bealey Avenue to extend past the frontage of the next two properties. These properties are occupied by a dentist and The Goals Centre who agree with time limit parking in this location.

There are *no stopping* lines along the Colombo Street frontage of the shops and they rely on the limited number of short term parking spaces on Bealey Avenue and across the street which they share with the after hours surgery. Residents in the area would still be entitled to legally use the proposed zone for overnight parking.

As Bealey Avenue is classified a Major Arterial road in this area, the Board's recommendation will be referred to the Council for resolution.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the northern side of Bealey Avenue commencing at a point 18 metres east of the intersection with Colombo Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 22 metres.

Chairperson's Recommendation: That the officer's recommendation be adopted.
