

34. DUAL MEMBERSHIP OF COMMUNITY BOARDS AND TERRITORIAL AUTHORITIES AND PRIVATE MEMBERS BILL

The purpose of this report is to report back to the Board on the Council’s decision on the above.

At its meeting on 2 June the Board recommended to the Council:

“That the Council be requested to support the private members Bill in respect of dual membership of Community Boards and territorial authorities, based on this Board’s experience.”

For information it is advised that the Council resolved as follows:

1. That the Council not make a submission on the Bill, but that Community Board Chairpersons make a submission on behalf of their Boards if the Boards so wish.
2. That the Council not institute a review of the function and role of Community Board members at this time but that any problems in the implementation of current terms of reference be referred to the City Manager for resolution.

Recommendation: That the report be received.

Chairperson’s Recommendation: That the Shirley/Papanui Community Board supports the private members Bill in respect of dual membership of Community Boards and territorial authorities.
