The purpose of this report is to seek to have the City Services Committee set up a subcommittee to assist with the evaluation and recommendation of the tenders for the next major contract in the Christchurch Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade.

Tenders closed on 1 September 1999 for the Christchurch Wastewater Treatment Plant Solids Contact Tanks and Sludge Processing Facilities Contract (99/2000-06). This contract, worth in the order of \$4M, provides mechanical equipment and facilities for running the \$7.6M Clarifiers (contract let in February this year). This mechanical work contract for which tenders have just closed will be reported to the October City Services Committee, and is made up largely of a wide range of equipment supply with some installation and associated civil works. Due to the range and complexities of the options for equipment supply, eg trade off between capital costs and long-term operating costs, it would be very useful to have the full understanding and support of a subcommittee for input during the tender evaluation and reporting process.

and recommendation for the Solids Contact Tanks and Sludge
