NATIONAL LOCAL AUTHORITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WORKERS' CONFERENCE

The Porirua City Council is hosting this year's National Local Authorities Community Development Workers' Conference which is to be held in Porirua on 10–12 November (refer attached flyer).

This conference provides the only regular opportunity for both elected members and community development workers from local authorities around the country to meet together for the purpose of:

- Sharing information about community development work
- Learning about what other local authorities are doing in community development
- Developing skills and knowledge in community development
- Meeting and making links with community development people from other local authorities.

Workshops and discussion topics include:

- Everything you need to know about community development
