The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of angle parking in Clothier Street.

Clothier Street is a local street that runs between Tuam Street and Essex Street. It serves predominantly commercial premises. The street is some 14 metres wide and there is unrestricted parallel parking on both sides.

The proposal is to change the parallel parking on the eastern side of the road to help overcome problems where there is a short fall in parking in the street. There are two other parking restrictions to be put in place in Tuam Street that will affect the amount of street parking and the marking of these angle parks will also help offset this loss.

The proposed angle parking will increase the number of spaces from 22 to 43. The change is welcomed by the adjacent commercial premises and has the support of the Parking Operations Manager.

Recommendation: That angle parking spaces are marked on the eastern side of Clothier Street from Tuam Street to Essex Street.
