Corporate Plan Output: Signs and Markings	

The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of “Give Ways” against Heathcote Street, Oak Street, and Portman Street at their intersections with Ferry Road.

Ferry Road, through the shopping area, is to have kerb and channel renewed in February. As part of the reconstruction pedestrian islands are to be placed at St Johns Street, Portman Street, and Heathcote Street. A recommendation from the safety audit is that a “Give Way” be placed at Heathcote Street, Oak street and Portman Street to allow traffic to clear from the main road into the side streets.

- Recommendation:**
1. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Heathcote street at its intersection with Ferry Road.
 2. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Oak Street at its intersection with Ferry Road.
 3. That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Portman Street at its intersection with Ferry Road.
