

11. PROPOSED NEW ROAD NAME – 280 CASHMERE ROAD

The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval of the Board to one new road name.

WIG/98/6691 L Dann and L Macbeth, 280 Cashmere Road

The applicants are creating a small cul de sac to serve five residential allotments. They have proposed the name Boonwood for the cul de sac. There is a substantial historical connection with early Chch in this choice of name. The name joins both applicants' family names. Laurence Dann is the son of Molly Dann, a niece of the late C E Boon who established the baking company of that name. Lindsay Macbeth is the daughter of Marion Macbeth (nee Wood) who is the great granddaughter of W D Wood, one of the Wood Brothers who established Wood's Flour Mill in Addington, still a significant landmark today. One family milled the flour, the other baked bread.

Boon Street does exist, however it is unlikely that any confusion will arise between Boon Street and Boonwood (Close, Place or Gardens) and they are situated in different postal zones.

Recommendation: That the Board approve the name Boonwood for this new cul de sac.
