

## 8. CARLYLE STREET BUS STOP

The purpose of this report is to create a new bus stop on the northern side of Carlyle Street to the west of Gasson Street.

The new bus services that have been recently extended to the Science Alive complex are now attracting more users and a number of requests have been received for an extra bus stop to be located in Carlyle Street. At present there is one stop located in Carlyle Street east of Colombo Street and the next stop is at the Science Alive Complex. It is proposed to locate a new bus stop in Carlyle Street on the north side near to the Gasson Street Intersection. This area is presently unrestricted.

The new bus stop has the support of Environment Canterbury, the Parking Operations Manager and one of the adjacent Property occupiers. The other site is presently available for lease.

**Recommendation:** That a bus stop be created on the northern side of Carlyle Street commencing at a point 72 metres measured in a westerly direction from a point opposite the western kerblines of Gasson Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 18 metres.

**Chairperson's Recommendation:** That the officer's recommendation be adopted.
