

25. NAMING OF RESERVES – SALISBURY STREET & STANMORE ROAD

The purpose of this report is to give the Board the opportunity to recommend names for reserves in Salisbury Street and Stanmore Road to the Parks and Recreation Committee.

At the previous meeting of the Board held on 5 July 2000, the Board set up a working party of Anna Crighton, Liz McRostie, Aaron O'Brien and Bob Todd to consider suitable names. This working party met on 2 August 2000, immediately before the Community Board meeting.

The working party makes the recommendations which follow to the Board:

1. STANMORE ROAD / TUAM STREET RESERVE

That the name *Essex Reserve* be recommended to the Parks and Recreation Committee for this reserve.

2. NURSERY ROAD RESERVE

That it be recommended to the City Streets Unit that this area of land which is at present legal road be named *Welcome Rest* and have its status formalised as a reserve.

3. 84 STANMORE ROAD

That the name *Doris Lusk Corner* be recommended to the Parks and Recreation Committee.

4. SALISBURY STREET RESERVE

That the name *Cambridge Green* be recommended to the Parks and Recreation Committee.
